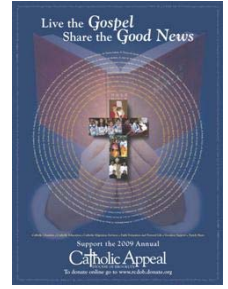

As I pass the torch of leadership to you, I assure you and all the parishioners a place in my prayers. Please remember me in yours.

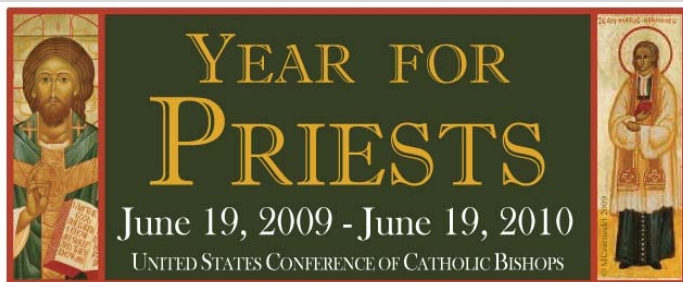
